2.Apologies: Mike Collins

3.<u>Approval of minutes of meeting held on 27th August</u> proposed Tony Harris ; seconded Yvonne Stuart.

4.Matters arising from previous minutes:

- **1. Extractors**: It was decided that one committee member, Andy Watson, would be responsible for keeping note of anyone borrowing an extractor, those holding extractors at their premises would email him with the name of borrower and date borrowed so he could keep records up to date.
- 2. <u>Combination lock on cabin</u>: The committee decided on a new combination number for the lock and Ron Clark agreed to change the number.
- 3. <u>Sugar collection</u>: As sugar was still being collected , the final date for uplift would now be 30th September.

5. Treasurers report:

- 1. £380 had been received from the Huntly Development Group for their training day.
- 2. Two aluminium cases had been ordered for the safekeeping of the microscopes at a cost of £100 for the two.
- 3. Bank balance was now standing at £6731.78.

6. Secretary's report

7. Beam project: Tony produced the following report:

For the month of September I have worked 70 hours on the beam project although I have only claimed payment for the contracted 40 hours.

I have claimed for 348 miles (£139.20) mainly in mentoring new beekeepers but not claimed for an additional 104 miles.

<u>Talks to community</u> groups I have given a talk to the Elgin Inner Wheel Group and spent all day at Elgin Academy on 13th September giving talks to 5 classes of year 4 students(over 100 students in total)

<u>Honeybee Health and Disease Course</u> 1st September :Andy and Anne assisted me in running the MBA Honey Bee Health Day and it was fully subscribed raising £144 gross towards MBA funds

Elgin Food Festival Yvonne, Davy and Donna ran a stall at the above event at Moray College

<u>Birnie Apiary</u> The bees have been treated for varroa and feeding will be completed by this weekend. It must be said that the bees are not in good condition after all the attention they have received this summer.

End of Project reports: I am continuing to collect data for the end of project reports.

Conclusion: Our commitments to the project in terms of volunteer time, talks to Community Groups, Shows etc. are now fully met. We are within budget and may well be underspent. If you have any unclaimed mileage get them in asap.
